- We believe in good, healthy soil and working with the best ingredients. We grow as much of our produce and flowers as possible on-site at our Home Farm.
- Our Home Farm is certified organic, and our Market Garden is certified bio-dynamic.
- We work with the seasons and at nature's pace. Our cutting garden down at the Market Garden provides us with fresh blooms throughout most of the year, and we always look to the farm and gardens to inform what goes onto the plate.
- We propagate trees from our own Heckfield arboretum to sequester tonnes of carbon.
- Our House is BREEAM certified.
- Our bio-mass boiler provides the majority of our heating when possible, and rely on renewables to supplement.
- 70,000 litres of water is extracted daily from our on-site bore hole
- We send zero waste to landfill.
- We are certified by FuturePlus

A KEY TO THE HOUSE

PERHAPS A KEY TO THE HOUSE IS EXACTLY WHAT YOUR EVENT CALLS FOR. HECKFIELD PLACE IS AVAILABLE FOR EXCLUSIVE BOOKINGS – ALLOWING FOR PRIVATE USE OF THE HOUSE, ITS 46 ROOMS, RESTAURANTS AND GROUNDS.

We offer three different ways to make our House your home—ranging from use of the House, its restaurants and immediate grounds to a key that unlocks all that Heckfield has to offer and assures the utmost privacy.

OPTION 1: A KEY TO THE HOUSE

- A key to the House offers the best of our House and its immediate grounds.
- Enjoy use of the entire House, Marle and Hearth restaurants, the Assembly and Dining Room event spaces, Italian Terrace and the Pleasure Grounds surrounding the House.
- It does not include exclusive use of the Upper Walled Garden, Glass House and Circus Maximus, however these areas are open and available to enjoy.
- The Bothy will also remain open to guests and a handful of members. Members will be allowed use of the Upper Walled Garden and the wider estate for wild swimming and access to our Home Farm.
- This option is best suited to large celebrations of up to 120 guests during the day and 90 guests staying overnight



OPTION II: A KEY TO THE HOUSE AND WALLED GARDENS

- A Key to the House and Walled Gardens offers all that a Key to the House provides, with the addition of exclusive access to the Upper Walled Garden, Glass House and Circus Maximum.
- The Upper Walled Garden and Glass House are the ideal setting for cocktail receptions or an intimate rehearsal dinner, surrounded by beautiful seasonal botanicals.
- Additionally, it also allows for exclusive access to our lakes, including our Pavilion which is licenced for wedding ceremonies.
- The Bothy will remain open to guests and a handful of members. They will not be allowed access to the Walled Gardens or wider estate.
- Up to 150 guests can be accommodated during the day with a marquee on Circus Maximus or at Big Thumper overlooking our Lower Lake, and 90 guests staying overnight.



OPTION III: A KEY TO HECKFIELD – A FULL EXCLUSIVE BOOKING

- A Key to Heckfield offers exclusive use of all that our beautiful House and estate have to offer.
- This option offers total privacy, with access to the estate only allowed to those attending the event.
- It offers all that a Key to the House and Walled Gardens provides, in addition to exclusive use of The Bothy.
- The Bothy offers ample room to relax and unwind with an indoor swimming pool, 6 treatment rooms, The Oak Terrace with an outdoor Hydrotherapy pool and thermal experiences and The Sun Room fuelled by the culinary imagination of Skye Gynge and nutrient-rich seasonal produce grown yards away at the biodynamic Market Garden.
- Up to 150 guests can be accommodated during the day with a marquee on Circus Maximus or at Big Thumper overlooking our Lower Lake, and 90 guests staying overnight.

We offer preferential pricing for all exclusive bookings during the months of January and February.

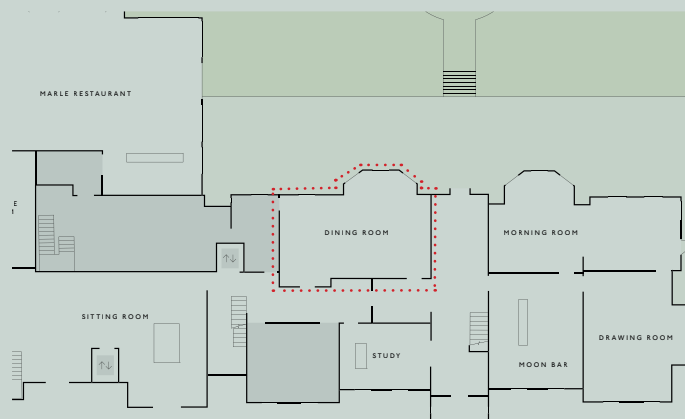

DINING ROOM - 58M²

THE ORIGINAL DINING ROOM OF HECKFIELD PLACE, WITH EXPANSIVE VIEWS ACROSS THE ITALIAN TERRACE AND ITS PLEASURE GROUNDS.

The 58m² room features floor to ceiling sash windows with the original oak shutters and a beautiful black marble fireplace adorned with the Shaw Lefevre family coat of arms. Our signature flower chandelier hangs over the long dining table, that can be set for an intimate gather of 10, or extended up to a celebration for 26.

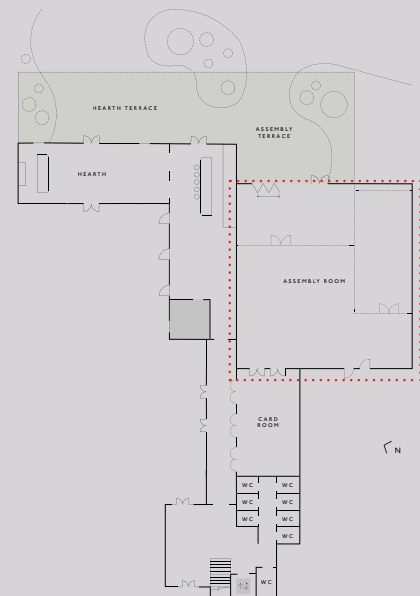
ASSEMBLY ROOM – 220M²

THE ASSEMBLY ROOM IS A LARGE BESPOKE EVENTS SPACE AT HECKFIELD PLACE, LOCATED ON THE GARDEN FLOOR OF THE HOTEL. THIS LIGHT-FILLED ROOM HAS FOLDING GLASS DOORS THAT OPEN ONTO A TERRACE WHICH OFFERS VIEWS AND DIRECT ACCESS TO THE PLEASURE GROUNDS, WOODLANDS AND LAKE.

The large space is versatile and flexible and can transform itself into many different iterations, from dining to meeting, dancing to painting, exercising to meditating. It has a beautiful polished terrazzo floor, and frames that support a draped ceiling, where flowers and lighting can easily be added.

- Our largest events space that is private and self-contained and situated in the House
- On the Garden floor, with views across the estate, accessible by stairs and a lift
- A space that can open up, or be divided into 3 separate spaces, providing meeting rooms, dining spaces and breakout rooms
- The adjacent Card Room works well as an Ante Room and entrance hall to the Assembly Room
- Close access to 7 WCs
- French windows that open to a terrace and the Pleasure grounds
- Equipped AV, TV, projector and video conferencing equipment for meetings

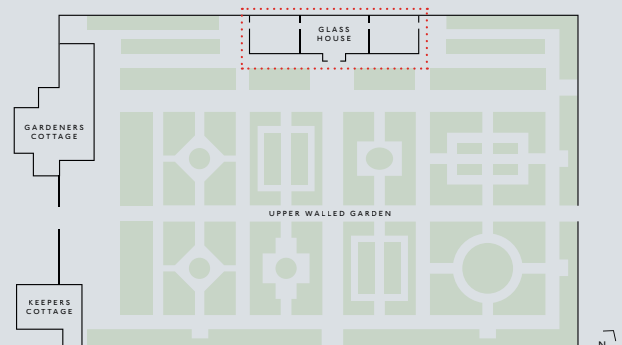
THE GLASS HOUSE - 93M²

THE GLASS HOUSE IS A SOUTH FACING GREENHOUSE SET AGAINST THE MELLOW BRICK WALLS OF THE UPPER WALLED GARDEN OF HECKFIELD PLACE. IT IS SURROUNDED BY THE PARTERRE GARDEN THAT IS LOVINGLY TENDED TO BY OUR TEAM.

The walls are lined with fruit trees, from apples and pears to cherries and grapes, while the beds delight throughout the seasons. Beautiful roses, towering artichokes and a spectacular round bed of peonies are on display if you are lucky enough to be there for their week of splendor.

- Situated in the Upper Walled Gardens of the grounds
- It is the working green house for the gardens and the House, with three separate rooms full of plants and hanging baskets

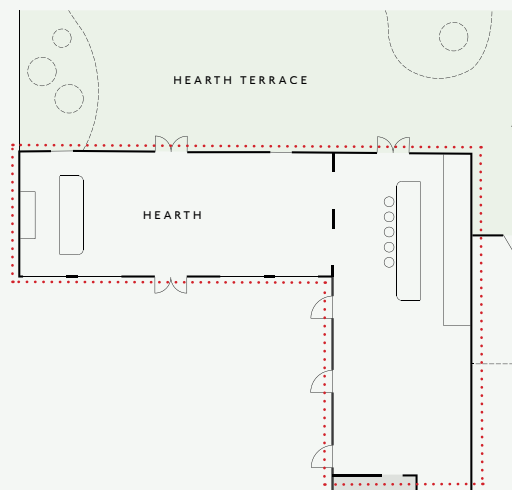
HEARTH - 120 M²

AT HEARTH, SKYE GYNGELL'S MENUS OF BIODYNAMIC AND ORGANIC PRODUCE ARE COOKED OVER AN OPEN FIREPLACE AND IN A WOOD BURNING OVEN. LOCATED IN WHAT WAS ONCE THE ORIGINAL STABLES OF THE HOUSE, THE RESTAURANT IS DIVIDED INTO THREE SPACES.

A hall with comfy seating areas leads into the bar, and then on to the main dining space which leads on to a stone flagged dining terrace that looks out across the Pleasure Grounds, lakes and woodlands.

DETAILS

- A wonderful space for a private celebration over a delicious and memorable meal
- Situated on the Garden Floor of the House, in the old Stables of the House with bare brick walls
- Chefs cook over a large open fireplace and wood burning stove
- Leading off the Boot Room and next to the Card Room and Assembly Room
- French windows open onto the Hearth Terrace, with views across the Pleasure Grounds of the estate
- Access to the lakes and woodlands is possible from the Terrace

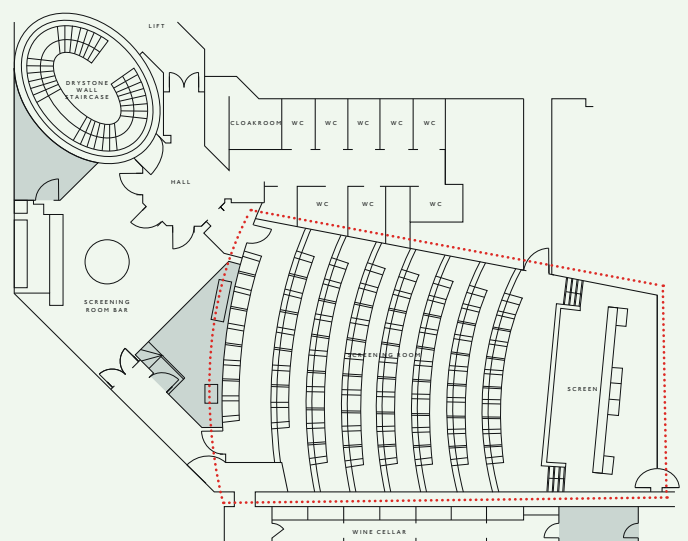


SCREENING ROOM - 200 M²

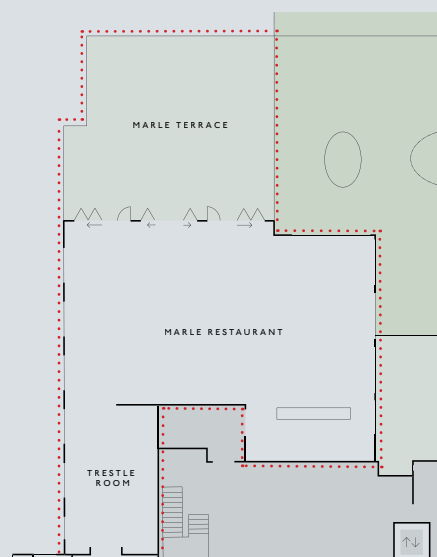


MARLE - 150 M²

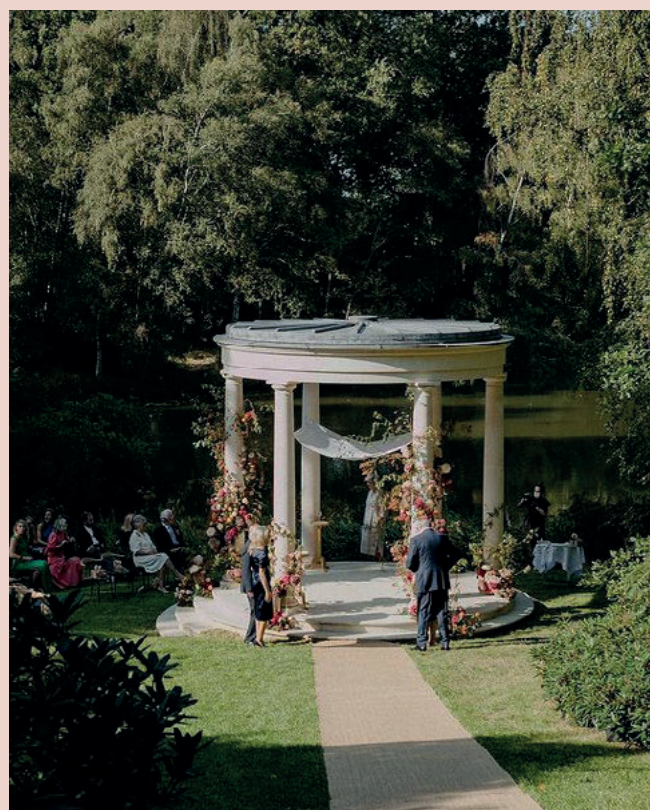

IF YOU PREFER TO TAKE YOUR EVENT OUTDOORS, HECKFIELD HAS MORE THAN A FEW OPTIONS TO SUIT.

- Our Pavilion by the Lower Lake is licenced for weddings and provides a beautifully serene backdrop best suited for spring, summer and autumn for up to 30 guests
- The Italian Terrace behind the House overlooks our Upper Lake, Woodlands and Pleasure Grounds and is well suited to wedding blessings
- Circus Maximus and our South Lawn provide ample room for a marquee or table set up for up to 150 guests, whilst allowing for convenient proximity to the House. A marquee can also be set up at Big Thumper down by our Lower Lake.

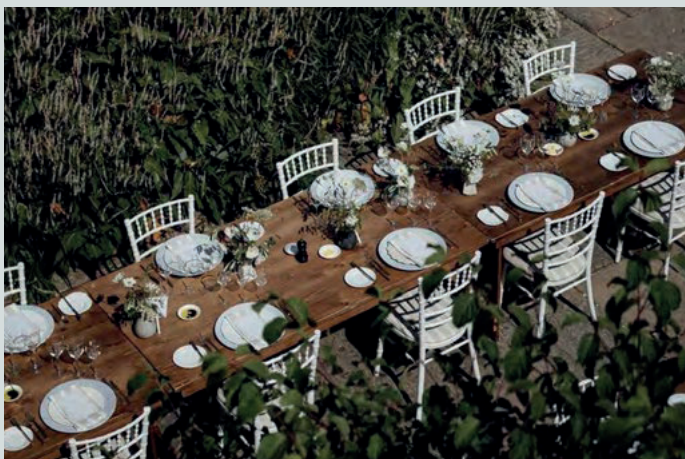
WEDDINGS

To ensure that your event will be a success, we request that you carefully read our general conditions below.

DEPOSIT

In order to secure your Event, Heckfield Place requires a 50% deposit of the totality of the service requested. The deposit received is not refundable. The remaining balance is due 30 days prior to the date of the event, and is not refundable. The booking will be considered confirmed once the funds have been received by Heckfield Place. Cancellation of the event is required in writing.

EVENT CONTRACT

A contract will be set for events mentioning all the discussed details. This contract aims to summarize all the arrangements and is used as the basis for any further changes. The contract must be returned to us signed together with the general conditions which can make up an integral part of the contract.

OUTSIDE CONTRACTORS

Any equipment and set up arranged from an outside contractor by the organizer must be approved by Heckfield Place. Any installation and dismantling of equipment by an outside contractor must begin and end within the confirmed period.

Any delivery of equipment by an outside contractor must be coordinated with Heckfield Place and through the designated service entrance. No materials or equipment can be stored at Heckfield Place. Heckfield Place declines any and all responsibility for the theft or damage to any materials ordered, delivered or stored on the premises by the organizer.
